

Whole Child Model School District and School Agreement

Metro RESA, through the responsibilities of the Wraparound Services Coordinator, will commit to:

- 1. Coach identified districts and schools in creating a Whole Child Model School Leadership Team to support, implement, and coordinate whole child services and supports for students and families in a responsive and relevant way
- 2. Assist schools with conducting, collecting and analyzing quantitative and qualitative data to identify academic and non-academic student, family, staff and community needs at a deep engagement level of at least 75%
- 3. Aid schools in identifying whole child community resources, organizations, nonprofits, and governmental entities based on identified whole child service and support priorities
- 4. Convene community organizations and district/school leaders to connect services, share best practices and align non-academic supports with the school's identified needs
- 5. Assist the school/district with targeted support for readiness, planning, implementation and sustainability of the whole child model school framework through the following four pillars: 1) Integrated Student Supports, 2) Expanded and Enriched Learning Time and Opportunities, 3) Active Family and Community Engagement, and 4) Collaborative Leadership and Practices

The School agrees to the following:

- 1. Develop leadership and pillar teams of students, families, staff and community members to support, implement, and coordinate the identified needs and services of students, families, staff and communities in a responsive and relevant way
- 2. Hire or assign a full-time staff member to support sustainability of teams, operations, and service delivery for the Whole Child Model School
- 3. Meet regularly and work collaboratively with the Metro RESA Wraparound Services Coordinator
- 4. Locate and/or renovate space (if needed) to provide a Hub for whole child model school services and supports to be delivered
- 5. Collect and analyze quantitative and qualitative data to identify academic and non-academic needs of students, families, staff and community members at a deep engagement level of at least 75% for all stakeholder groups
- 6. Develop a whole child model school action plan based on qualitative and quantitative data priorities for external partnerships and student/family service delivery
- 7. Engage in additional work as needed to connect students/families with whole child services and supports

The School District agrees to the following:

- 1. Work collaboratively with the Metro RESA and School Wraparound Services Coordinator by sharing existing district-level community partnerships and assisting in establishing new partnerships based on identified whole child model school priorities
- 2. Support the development of whole child model schools through a budget which may include the use of local, state, or federal funds, grants, foundation or in-kind donations to assist with start-up, planning and sustainability of services
- 3. Assist with legal agreements (Partnership Agreements/MOUs/MOAs) to embed synergistic whole child model services and supports into identified schools
- 4. Work collaboratively with Metro RESA to build district capacity to support the Whole Child Model School framework through technical assistance and coaching support to Whole Child Model School Coordinators.
- 5. Serve as example/demonstration site to others once established and fully functioning
